

ELECTION ANNOUNCEMENT

May 26, 2015

The ballot question is whether or not to accept Springdale Local #1415 (11 members) into Fayetteville Local #667. The deadline date to have your ballots in is **SUNDAY, JUNE 21, 2015 at 1:00 pm.**

Please follow instructions closely. Otherwise, your ballot will be voided by the Election Committee in compliance with the Local Constitution.

Mark your ballot [as instructed] for your choice.

Remember NOT to sign the "Official Ballot Envelope" for which you will insert your completed ballot. Make sure to seal the envelope after inserting your ballot. Please do not mark anywhere else on the ballot except the box indicating your vote, and don't mark on the "Official Ballot Envelope" either.

Remember to sign the outside of the stamped self-addressed envelope which you will be sending to the Local containing the sealed "Official Ballot Envelope". Unsigned envelopes will cancel your vote. Also, please include your current mailing address.

Instructions are on the back of the ballot – as shown.

Blank ballots will be mailed to you on May 30, 2015 and you should receive them by or before June 3rd. If you do not receive your election / ballot letter by June 9th, please contact one of the officers.

INSTRUCTIONS

REFERENDUM:

This **BALLOT QUESTION** is — whether or not members in good-standing of the Fayetteville APWU Local #667 will accept the merger of Springdale APWU Local (11 members) into ours. Springdale has already agreed to the merger. Now it is up to Fayetteville whether or not to accept the merger. Vote YES or NO on the question by marking the opposite side of this ballot accordingly.

Please mark your ballot with a check or diagonal line or an "X". Then insert the ballot in the **OFFICIAL BALLOT ENVELOPE** and seal it. Next, place the **OFFICIAL BALLOT ENVELOPE** into the stamped envelope addressed to the Fayetteville Local. Do not mark or sign on the **OFFICIAL BALLOT ENVELOPE**. Ballots and the **OFFICIAL BALLOT ENVELOPE** MUST NOT be signed or marked in any way. However, do sign the stamped envelope [addressed to the Local] in the upper left hand corner and include your current mailing address. Next, don't forget to mail in your ballot.

The Local prefers mail-in ballots. However, ballots received on or before the meeting date that are properly sealed and signed will be counted.

Ballots will be counted at the Meeting on Sunday, June 21, 2015.
